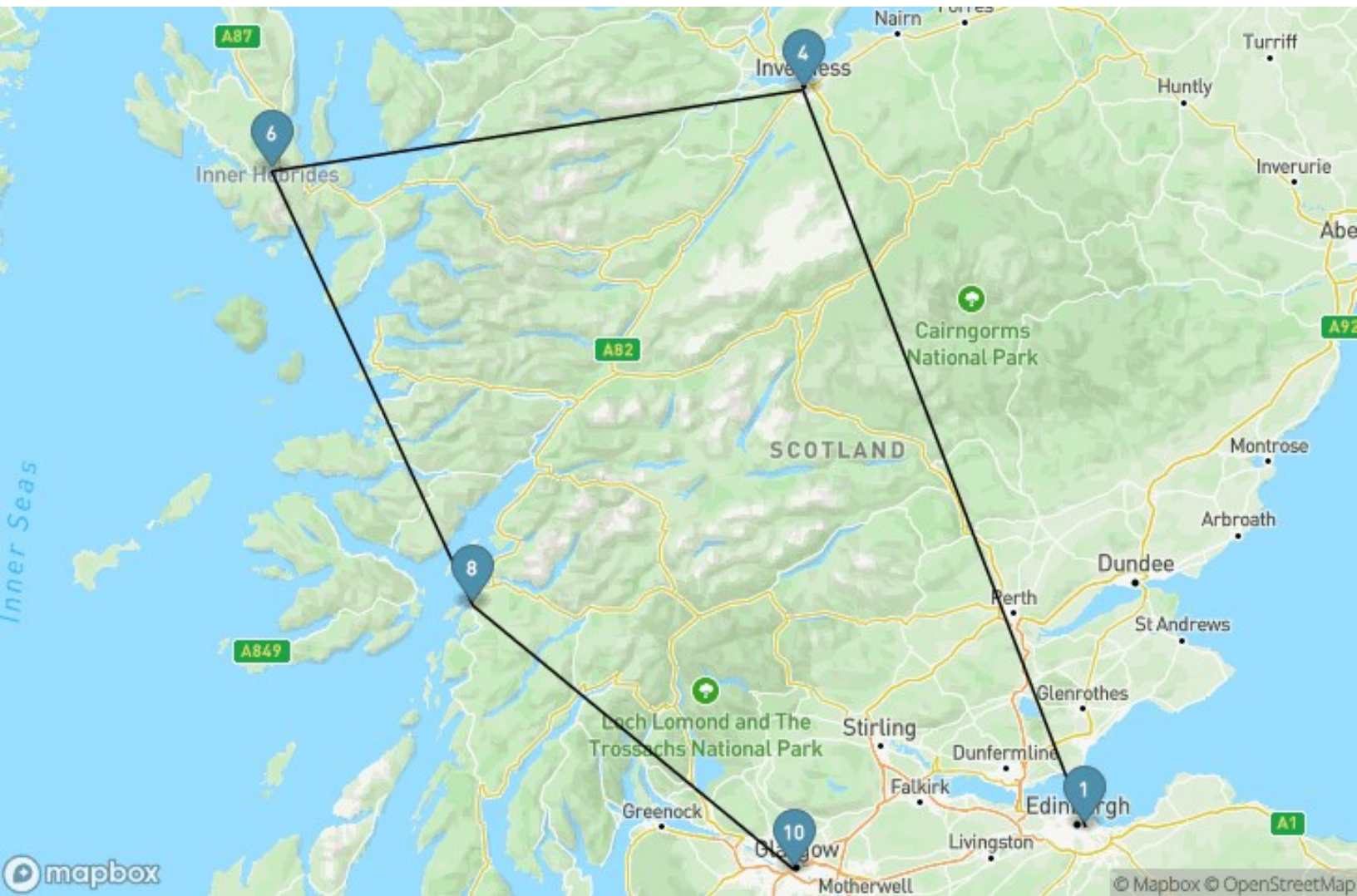

Stroll the renowned Royal Mile in Old Town, book-ended by the 12th-century Edinburgh Castle at one end, and the 16th-century Holyrood Palace at the other, residence of the British monarch in Scotland. Spot the prominent St Giles' Cathedral, a religious focal point for nearly 900 years. Pass the National Museum of Scotland and learn of the city's hidden subterranean passages running below street level. Visit the iconic Edinburgh Castle, perched on Castle Rock with an imposing stance upon the historic old town below. Stroll the courtyard and learn about the historic royal residence from the outside before leaving your guide while you visit the inside of the castle, where you can see the lavish interiors, and even the Crown Jewels.

Enjoy a fine selection of whisky drams at the Scotch Malt Whisky Society's Kaleidoscope Bar, sure to impress the most experienced of whisky connoisseurs. Led by one of the society's Ambassadors, you'll





sample the legendary flavors of the Scottish "Water of Life". Following your tasting, enjoy a complimentary main course from the bar menu.

DAY 3 - SAT, JUN 04, 2022: EDINBURGH

A Journey Back in Time

Departing with a private driver-guide, you'll set out today for a full day tour to St Andrews and its scenic surrounds in the county of Fife. As a coastal area 1.5 hours northeast of Edinburgh, fishing still has a role here, but ultimately, it is to St Andrews, Scotland's oldest university town and the home of the world-famous Royal and Ancient Golf Club, that most visitors are drawn. Stroll the historic old town, where two of the original medieval gates are still in tact - the West Port, and the Sea Yett. See the oldest church in St Andrews, the Holy Trinity which dates to 1144, featuring a beautifully restored medieval exterior. Visit the cliff-top ruins of the 16th-century St Andrews Castle as well as the the stunning graveyard and ruins of the 12th - century Cathedral of St Andrew. South of St Andrews, the tiny stone harbors of the fishing villages of the East Neuk - Anstruther, Crail, St Monans and Pittenweem - are undeniably appealing, and worth dedicating some time to as you visit this part of Fife.

Onward and Upward

Take a short, self-guided walking transfer, as your hotel is located near the train station.

Depart by train from Edinburgh to Inverness. Approximate travel time is 3.5 hours.

Meet your private driver and vehicle for a transfer from Inverness train station to your hotel.

Meet your private driver for a transfer to the Clansman Harbor, where you'll board the 250-passenger Jacobite Warrior boat to cruise the mysterious waters of Loch Ness. Here you'll enjoy on-board audio bursting with fascinating facts and legends as you sail. During your voyage, you'll hop ashore for a one-hour visit to explore the historic 13th-16th century ruins of Urquhart Castle and its turbulent past - serving a role in the 14th-century Wars of Scottish Independence. Re-board the ship and set sail back to the harbor where your private transfer will take you back to your hotel. Along with the help of an on-board sonar system, be sure to keep your eye out for a potential *Nessie* spotting as you cruise, the legendary (mythical?) monster that is said to take refuge in the depths of the Loch.

DAY 5 - MON, JUN 06, 2022: INVERNESS

It's All Ancient History

With your private driver-guide, set out for a full day of touring in the stunning surrounds of Inverness. You'll visit the 15th-century Cawdor Castle, romantically linked to Shakespeare's Macbeth, and a fantastic example of a fairy-tale Scottish castle steeped in history. Stroll the beautiful gardens, view the legendary Hawthorne tree at the heart of the castle, admire family portraits in the lavish Drawing Room, see the commemorative mantelpiece in the Dining Room, and take in the century-old contraptions in the Old Kitchen. Continue on to Culloden Battlefield, home of the legendary Jacobite uprising in 1745 that was tragically defeated by loyalist troops. Step back in time as you walk the footpaths and visit the 20-foot memorial cairn, erected in 1881. After, you'll get to visit the garrison fortress of Fort George. Strategically built by the sea, the fortress had an immediate reinforcements and supply route in the event of a siege, put in place with the intention to pacify the Scottish Highlands after the Jacobite rebellion.

Winding the Wind-Swept Shorelines

Depart Inverness today with a private driver-guide on a full day transfer to the remarkably stunning Isle of Skye, admiring the dramatic scenery of the Scottish Highlands en route. Before crossing the bridge to Skye, you'll visit the beautiful Eilean Donan Castle, first established by Alexander II in the 13th-century to help protect the area from Viking incursions. Situated on a small, separate tidal island, this highly photogenic medieval castle is one of Scotland's most iconic images. The castle as we know it today was reconstructed as a family home between 1912 and 1932 while its bridge was also added, a structure that is as much a part of the classic image as the very castle itself.

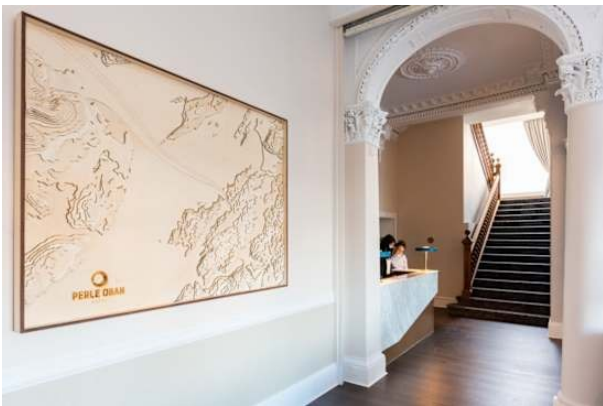
Sights and Insights
